

In Memoriam Professor Constantin Bușe
(October 19,1960, Oteșani, Romania - February 4, 2020, Timișoara, Romania)



Professor Constatin Bușe, age 60, passed away on 4 February 2020 after a severe illness. Constantin Bușe was born on 19 October 1960 in Oteșani, County Vâlcea, Romania, where he attended the gymnasium studies. He continued his secondary education at the Energy High School of Râmnicu Vâlcea and in the years 1980 - 1984 he studied mathematics at the West University of Timișoara.

Because in the 80's of the last century the teaching positions in Romanian university education were blocked and all graduates of mathematics faculties could choose only for a position in gymnasium school, high school or industry, Professor Constantin Bușe began his teaching career in 1984 as a teacher of mathematics at the Gymnasium School No. 6 of Slatina, in the period 1986 - 1990 he was a teacher of mathematics at the National College "Ion Minulescu" of Slatina, between 1990 and 1991 he was a professor of mathematics at the National College "C.D. Loga" of Timișoara, and in 1991 he held the position of assistant professor in the Department of Mathematics at the West University of Timișoara.

In 1996, Professor Constantin Buşe got his PhD degree in Mathematics at the West University of Timișoara, based on his thesis: “Contributions to the study of asymptotic behavior of evolutionary processes in abstract spaces”. In 2003 he became Full Professor in the Department of Mathematics at the West University of Timișoara and in 2016 he started teaching as a Full Professor in the Department of Mathematics at the Polytechnic University of Timișoara.

The scientific activity of Professor Constantin Buşe was extensive and comprised many fields, especially Ordinary Differential Equations, Operator Semigroup Theory, Stability Theory for Abstract Differential and Integral Equations, Linear Dynamical Systems with Control, Classical Mathematical Analysis and General Theory of Inequalities.

Throughout his career he has collaborated with numerous fellow professors at preeminent institutions across the world. Some significant collaborations include: Visiting Professor at the Victoria University of Technology, Australia, 2001 and 2004; Scientific Research in the Department of Mathematics at the University of Aveiro, Portugal, 2007; Foreign Professor at the Abdus Salam School of Mathematical Sciences, Government College University, Lahore, Pakistan, 2006 – 2017; Visiting Professor at the University Paris 1 Pantheon Sorbonne, France, 2011; Visiting Professor at the Department of Mathematics of the Western Kentucky University, USA, 2011 and 2017.

Since 1991 he has published over seventy research papers in over thirty international journals.

A man with a special sensitivity, modest and honest, with great love of people and for teaching, self-control, strong will, exemplary work ethic, firmness, consistency and perseverance are in a few words, some of the qualities of Professor Constantin Buşe. For the support, dedication, and patience with which he has contributed to the consolidation of knowledge, influencing the road in life and career of many students, we greatly regret his departure from this world, bringing a tribute of gratitude from our hearts.

May God rest his Soul in peace!.
