



THE INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM
ON DIFFERENTIAL EQUATIONS AND
MATHEMATICAL PHYSICS DEDICATED
TO THE 90th BIRTHDAY ANNIVERSARY
OF ACADEMICIAN I. VEKUA

The Symposium was held in Tbilisi, Georgia, in June 21–25, 1997. It was organized by the Georgian Academy of Sciences and I. Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University with the support of President of Georgia Mr. Eduard Shevardnadze.
